

# Tranquil Tide Window Card

## Supplies:

- Stamps: Tranquil Thoughts (#154483)
- Ink: Rocco Rose (#150080)
- Paper: Rocco Rose (#150882), Basic White (#159276)
- Designer Paper: Hydrangea Hill (#154570)
- Tools & Accessories: Tranquil Dies (#154331), Stitched Rectangles (#151820)
- Other: Multipurpose Liquid Glue (#110755), Stampin' Dimensionals (#104430)

## Measurements:

- Card Base: Rocco Rose – 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" scored at 4-1/4"
- Cardstock #2: Basic White – 8-1/8" x 5-1/4" scored at 4-1/16"
- Cardstock #3: Basic White – 2-3/4" x 4-1/4" (for stitched rectangle)
- Cardstock #4: Rocco Rose – 5-3/4" x 4-1/4" (for Tranquil Dies front trim)
- Cardstock #5: Scrap Rocco Rose & Basic White (for flowers & leaves)
- Designer Series Paper: Hydrangea Hill – 5-1/4" x 4-1/8"

## Instructions:

- Fold the card base and, using the 6<sup>th</sup> from the smallest Stitched Rectangle, center it on the front of the card base and cut out. Save the cut out piece.
- Take the 2-3/4" x 4-1/4" piece of Basic White and using the 5<sup>th</sup> from the smallest Stitched Rectangle, cut out that rectangle.
- Take the piece of Rocco Rose 5-3/4" x 4-1/4" and cut the corner 'frame' from the Tranquil Dies.

- Using Rocco Rose ink, stamp the triple flower stamp on scrap Basic White. Using Rocco Rose ink, stamp two leaves on a piece of Rocco Rose cardstock. Cut all these with the coordinating Tranquil Dies.
- Cut the piece of Hydrangea Hill DSP and cut to 5-1/4" x 4-1/8". Glue this to the front of the Basic White piece that was scored at 4-1/6". Trim off any little extra from the edge – if you have any extra.
- Take this piece of Basic White and glue it into the Rocco Rose card base. When gluing it down, tuck it almost up to the fold. You want to leave about 1/16" at the top to allow the card front to fold down over this insert in a "little friendlier way". ☺
- Put a little glue on the back of the Stitched Rectangle piece that you cut out of the card base. Holding down the card front, place this rectangle into the hole fitting it into the space and gluing it down on top of the Basic White/DSP insert.
- Stamp a greeting with Rocco Rose on the White Stitched Rectangle. Center and glue it to the front of the Rocco Rose Stitched Rectangle.
- Optional: Spray the flowers, leaves and 'frame' with a sheer shimmer craft spray. Let it dry.
- Decide your placement of the flowers and leaves. Glue the leaves down. Put just a little glut on the bottom of the flowers and a mini dimensional on the top of the flowers and put in place.
- Take the Tranquil Dies 'frame' (after it dries from the spritzing) and glue it to the front of the card base.
- Stamp a greeting of your choice on the inside (or write your own personal note).
- Glue a 1" x 5-1/4" strip of the DSP to the bottom of the inside.
