

Butterfly Brilliance Sponged Rainbow

Supplies:

- Stamps: Butterfly Brilliance #155092
- Ink: Misty Moonlight, Magenta Madness, Just Jade, Bumblebee
- Paper: Magenta Madness cardstock, Basic White cardstock
- Designer Paper: Natural Touch Specialty Paper #156825
- Tools & Accessories: Brilliant Wings Dies #155543
- Other: Metallic Mesh Ribbon #153550

Measurements:

- Card Base: 4.25 x 11 inches
- Cardstock #2: 5 x 6 inch
- Designer Series Paper: 4 x 5.5 inches

Instructions:

- Using a sponge or sponge dauber, add color to the stamp (mounted on the Stamparatus), working from light to dark (Bumblebee, Just Jade, Magenta Madness, Misty Moonlight) on the piece of Basic White cardstock.
- Die cut the butterflies with the large butterfly outline die. Die cut the “bubbles” die in the Natural Touch paper several times in the direction that your butterflies are flying.
- Attach the piece of DSP to the card front leaving a small border on left and right.
- Take a nine inch piece of the Metallic Mesh Ribbon and start on the bottom twist and adhere it to the card base with a strong adhesive, like Stamping Seal+ in the four places where you will put a butterfly.
- Using one or two dimensionals for each butterfly adhere them onto the card front from largest to smallest moving up the card on top of the twisted and glued pieces of the Metallic Mesh Ribbon.
