

Color & Contour – 2021 May

Supplies:

- Stamps: Color & Contour Bundle (158356)
- Ink: Soft Succulent Classic Stamp Pad (155778), Fresh Freesia Classic Stamp Pad (155611); Basic Gray Classic Stamp Pad (149165)
- Paper: Soft Succulent Cardstock (155776), Fresh Freesia Cardstock (150884), Basic White Card Stock (159276)
- Designer Paper: Pansy Petals Designer Series Paper (155807)
- Tools & Accessories: Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653), Blender Pens (102845)
- Other: Stampin' Seal (152813), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430)

Measurements:

- Card Base: Soft Succulent 5-1/2"x8-1/2" scored at 4-1/4",
- Cardstock #2: Basic White 2-1/4"x5", 5/8"x1-7/8", 4x5-1/4" for inside, scrap to die cut flower
- Cardstock #3: Fresh Freesia 2-1/2"x5-1/4", scrap to cut label die cut
- Designer Series Paper: 1-1/2"x5-1/4"

Instructions:

- Cut approx. 1" off front of card base with Scallop Die. Adhere gingham Designer Series Paper to Basic White card stock and adhere to inside of card.
- Stamp flower outline in Basic Gray on Basic White scrap. Stamp flower interior with Fresh Freesia. Use Blender Pen with Soft Succulent ink to color center of flower. Die cut flower out.
- Stamp flower bud outlines in Basic Gray on Basic White strip. Stamp flower insides with Fresh Freesia. Adhere to Fresh Freesia strip and adhere to card front above scallops.

- Stamp just “thank you” with Basic Gray ink on Basic White label. Die cut Fresh Freesia label and adhere Thank You. Use dimensionals to adhere flower and label to card front.
