Supplies:

- Stamps: Pansy Patch #154999
- Ink: Evening Evergreen #155576
- Paper: Soft Succulent #155776, Evening Evergreen #155574, Basic White #159276
- Designer Paper: Pansy Petals #155807
- Tools & Accessories: Paper Trimmer #152392, Stampin' Seal + #149699, Double Oval Punch #154242, 2021-2023 In Color Jewels #155571, Bumblebee Trinkets #155568, Dimensionals #104430

Measurements:

- Card Base: Soft Succulent 11 x 4 ¼, scored at 4 ¼ & 5 ½, scrap for scallop punch
- Cardstock #2: Evening Evergreen 1 x 4, 4 x 4
- Cardstock #3: Basic White scrap for oval punch for sentiment, 4 x 4 square for inside
- Designer Series Paper: 3 ¾ x ¾, 3 ¾ x 3 ¾

Instructions:

- Score card base & put adhesive on the inside of the 1 ¼ x 4 ¼ fold to create the 'spine'
- Attach the 3 ¾ x ¾ DSP to the 4 x 1 Evening Evergreen & attach it to the 'spine'. Attach the 3 ¾ square DSP to the 4 square Evening Evergreen & attach that to the front of the storybook.
- Stamp sentiment on the Basic White & punch with Double Oval punch. Attach that to scallop oval punched from the Soft Succulent scrap. Attach that to the card front with dimensionals.
- Accessorize the front with the In Color Jewels and Bumblebee Trinkets



- Attach the 4 x 4 Basic White square to the inside of the card and stamp with sentiment if desired.
