

# Turtle Friends

## Supplies:

- Stamps: Turtle Friends (#155356 or bundle with the Turtle Punch for 10% off #155819)
- Ink: Evening Evergreen (#155576), Polished Pink (#155712), Evening Evergreen Stampin' Blends Combo Pack (#155517), Soft Succulent Stampin' Blends Combo Pack (#155521)
- Paper: Polished Pink (#155710), Evening Evergreen (#155574), Soft Succulent (#155776), Basic White (#159276)
- Designer Paper: Pansy Petals (#155807)
- Tools & Accessories: Turtle Punch (#155372), Hippo & Friends Dies (#153585), Hammered Metal 3D Embossing Folder (150646), Linen Thread (#104199), Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (#149653), Paper Trimmer (#152392)
- Other: Multipurpose Liquid Glue (#110755), Stampin' Dimensionals (#104430), Mini Glue Dots (#103663), Wink of Stella Clear Glitter Brush (#141897)

## Measurements:

- Card Base: Polished Pink 4-1/4" x 11", score at 5-1/2"

- Cardstock #2: Evening Evergreen 4" x 5-1/4"
- Cardstock #3: Soft Succulent 3-7/8" x 5-1/8"
- Designer Series Paper: Pansy Petals 1-3/4" x 5-1/8"
- Cardstock #4: Basic White 4" x 4-1/2" for stamped turtle and die cut

Instructions:

- Fold the scored Polished Pink Cardstock in half to form card base.
- Emboss the Soft Succulent Cardstock layer with the Hammered Metal 3D Embossing Folder using the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine.
- Adhere the DSP to the embossed Soft Succulent Cardstock using liquid glue, then wrap two 5-1/2" pieces of Linen Thread on the left side of the DSP, securing on the back with glue dots (or tape).
- Adhere the Soft Succulent layer to the Evening Evergreen Cardstock layer, then adhere to the Polished Pink card base using liquid glue.
- On the piece of Basic White Cardstock, stamp the large turtle image in Evening Evergreen ink, then stamp the shell detail also in Evening Evergreen ink. Punch the turtle out using the Turtle Punch, then color the turtle using the Light Soft Succulent Stampin' Blends. Color the turtle's toes with Light Evening Evergreen Stampin' Blends.
- On the piece of Basic White Cardstock, die cut the frame from the Hippo and Friends Dies using the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine. Stamp the small turtle image, small shell detail and sentiment in Evening Evergreen ink. Ink up a **small** portion of the grass image in Evening Evergreen ink and stamp between the small turtle's feet, as shown. Ink up the full grass image in Evening Evergreen ink and stamp where the larger turtle will be placed. Stamp the trio of hearts image in Polished Pink ink above where the larger turtle's head will be placed.
- Adhere the larger punched turtle to the stamped die cut using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Adhere the die cut to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Tie a double bow with two pieces of Linen Thread and adhere to card with glue dots.
- Add Wink of Stella Clear Glitter Brush to the Evening Evergreen stamped shells on the turtles.
