Supplies:

- Stamps: Handsomely Suited #154441
- Ink: none
- Paper: Basic Gray #121044, Smoky Slate #131202 plus scraps of both for collar and buttons
- Designer Paper: Well Suited Designer Series Paper #154562
- Tools & Accessories: Suit & Ties Dies #154322

Measurements:

- Card Base: Basic Gray 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" and scored at 4-1/4"
- Cardstock #2: Smoky Slate 2-1/4" x 4"

- Designer Series Paper: 5-1/2" x 4-1/4" plus scrap of contrasting pattern for tie

Instructions:

- Attach Smoky Slate 2-1/4" x 4" cardstock to top/center of card front.
- Die cut tie from DSP scrap and attach to Smoky Slate piece about 1/2" from the top.
- Die cut the collar and attach. Pop up using tiny dimensionals.
- Die cut "V" shape into Designer Series Paper. Attach to card front.
- Die cut two buttons in Basic Gray and attach below the V.
- Add sentiment inside card as desired.
