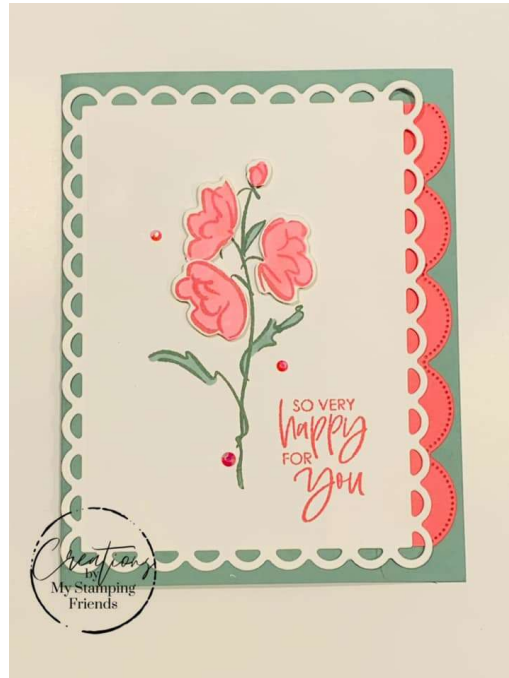


# Color & Contour Polished Pink Flower Card

## Supplies:

- Stamps: Color & Contour Bundle #158356
- Ink: Polished Pink #155712, Polished Pink Blends #155520, Soft Succulent #155778, Soft Succulent Blends #155521
- Paper: Basic White #159276, Polished Pink #155710, Soft Succulent #155776
- Tools & Accessories: Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine #149653, 2021-2023 In Color Jewels #155571
- Adhesives: Mini Stampin' Dimensionals #144108, Stampin' Dimensionals #104430, Stampin' Seal #152813

## Measurements:

- Card Base: Soft Succulent cardstock 5 ½" x 8 ½"; score at 4 ¼" and fold
- Cardstock #2: Polished Pink 1 ¼" x 5"
- Cardstock #3: Basic White 4 ¼" x 5 ½" die cut with large scalloped rectangle die, and scrap for the flower blossoms

## Instructions:

- Cut each piece listed in the measurements above.
- Fold Soft Succulent cardstock in half to form card base.
- Die cut Polished Pink cardstock with the scalloped edge die.

- Die cut Basic White cardstock with the large scalloped rectangle die.
- Stamp flower image in the center of the Basic White scalloped rectangle using Soft Succulent ink; color open leaves with the Light Soft Succulent Blends Marker.
- Stamp sentiment in the lower right corner of the Basic White scalloped rectangle using Polished Pink ink.
- Adhere the right edge of the Basic White scalloped rectangle over the piece of Polished Pink scalloped cardstock; adhere to the card base.
- Stamp the flower image a second time on a scrap of Basic White cardstock using Polished Pink ink.
- Color open flowers with the Light Polished Pink Blends Marker; cut out and adhere to the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Embellish card front with three Polished Pink 2021-2023 In Color Jewels.
