Supplies:

- Stamps: Counting Sheep (Sale-A-Bration) #156591
- Ink: Tuxedo Black Momento #132708, Granny Apple Green #146990
- Stampin' Blends Combo Pack: Petal Pink #154893, Gray Granite #154886, Granny Apple Green #154885, Flirty Flamingo #154884
- Paper: Bumblebee #153077, Pool Party #122924, Crumb Cake #120953, Granny Apple Green #146990, Basic White #159276,
- Designer Series Paper: Pattern Party (Host) #155426
- Tools & Accessories: Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine #149653, Sheep Dies (Sale-A-Bration) #156600, Scalloped Contour Dies #155560, Tasteful Textile 3D Embossing Folder #152718, Bumblebee Gingham Ribbon #153658, 2020-2022 In Color Square Jewels #155572, Paper Trimmer #152392, Multipurpose Liquid Glue #110775, Stampin' Dimensionals #104430, Mini Glue Dots #103683

Measurements:

- Card Base: Bumblebee 5-1/2" x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4 and folded in half
- Cardstock #2: Pool Party 5-1/4" x 4"
- Cardstock #3: Basic White 5-1/8" x 3-7/8"
- Designer Series Paper: 2-1/2" x 3-3/4"
- Cardstock #4: Granny Apple Green 3-1/4" x 1/2"
- Cardstock #5: Basic White 1-5/8" x 1/2" (for stamped sentiment)
- Cardstock for stamping and die cutting: scraps of Pool Party, Crumb Cake, Bumblebee and Basic White

Instructions:

- Emboss the Basic White Cardstock layer using the Tasteful Textile 3D Embossing Folder.
- Adhere the DSP layer to the embossed Basic White Cardstock.
- Adhere the Basic White Cardstock layer to the Pool Party Cardstock, then adhere to the Bumblebee card base.
- Die cut the scalloped rectangle from a piece of Pool Party Cardstock and adhere to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Stamp four of the grass images on the strip of Granny Apple Green Cardstock, then emboss the cardstock using the Tasteful Textiles 3D Embossing Folder. Adhere the strip of cardstock to the bottom of the scalloped rectangle using liquid glue.
- Die cut the fence from a scrap of Crumb Cake Cardstock and adhere to the scalloped rectangle using liquid glue.
- On a scrap of Basic White Cardstock, stamp the sheep and the party hat images in Momento ink.
- Color the sheep's face, ears and legs using Petal Pink Stampin' Blends.
- Color the sheep's feet using Light Gray Granite Stampin' Blends.
- Color the party hat with Light Granny Apple Green and Light Flirty Flamingo Stampin' Blends.
- Die cut the sheep and the party hat and adhere to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- On the strip of Basic White Cardstock, stamp the sentiment in Momento ink and adhere to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Die cut the sun from a scrap of Bumblebee Cardstock and adhere to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Tie a bow using the Bumblebee Gingham Ribbon and adhere to the card using Mini Glue Dots.
- Adhere three of the Bumblebee Square Jewels to the card, as shown.
