Supplies:

- Stamps: Cutest Halloween #156480
- Ink: Tuxedo Black Memento #132708
- Paper: Basic Black #121045, Highland Heather #146986, Smoky Slate #131202, Basic White #159276, Cute Halloween Designer Series Paper #156479
- Tools & Accessories: Halloween Punch #156482, Banners Pick A Punch #153608, Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine #149653, Layering Circles Dies #151770, Checks & Dots Embossing Folders #155432, Black & White Gingham Ribbon #156485, Cute Stars Adhesive Backed Sequins #156484, Paper Trimmer #152392, Multipurpose Liquid Glue #110775, Stampin' Dimensionals #104430, Mini Glue Dots #103683

Measurements:

- Card Base: Basic Black 4-1/4" x 11", scored at 5-1/2" and folded in half
- Cardstock #2: Highland Heather 4" x 5-1/4"
- Cardstock #3: Smoky Slate 3-7/8" x 5-1/8"
- Designer Series Paper: 2" x 5-7/8"
- Cardstock #4: Basic White 2-1/4" x 1/2" (for stamped sentiment)
- Cardstock for stamping and die cutting: scraps of Basic Black, Highland Heather and Basic White
- Card Interior: Basic White 4" x 5-1/4" and a scrap of Cute Halloween DSP

Instructions:

- Emboss the Smoky Slate Cardstock layer using the polka dot embossing folder.
- Adhere the DSP layer to the embossed Smoky Slate Cardstock.
- Adhere the Smoky Slate Cardstock layer to the Highland Heather Cardstock, then adhere to the Basic Black card base.
- Die-cut three 1-3/4" scalloped circles from Basic Black Cardstock.
- Die cut three 1-5/8" circles from Highland Heather Cardstock.
- Adhere the Highland Heather circles to the Basic Black scalloped circles using liquid glue, then adhere the circles to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- On the strip of Basic White Cardstock, stamp the sentiment in Memento ink, banner punch the right side of the strip and adhere to the card using Stampin Dimensionals.
- Punch out the cat and pumpkin from the coordinating pattern in the Cute Halloween DSP.
- Stamp the ghost and ghost face/arms in Memento ink on a scrap of Basic White Cardstock, then punch out the image.
- Adhere the cat, ghost and pumpkin to the circles on the card as shown, using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Tie a bow using the Black & White Gingham Ribbon and adhere to the card using Mini Glue Dots.
- Adhere three of the Cute Stars Adhesive Backed Sequins to the card, as shown.
- For the card interior: stamp the sentiment, ghost and ghost face in Memento ink on Basic White Cardstock, add a scrap strip of DSP and adhere layer inside the card.
