

Festive & Bright

Supplies:

- Stamps: Festive & Bright (#158536), Banner Year (#153464)
- Ink: Memento Black (#132708), Gorgeous Grape (#147099)
- Paper: Basic White (#159276), Basic Black (#121045), Fresh Freesia (#155613)
- Designer Paper: Beautifully Penned (#156630)
- Tools & Accessories: Festive Finishes Dies (#156565), Light & Dark Smokey Slate Blends (#154904), Dark Highland Heather Blends (#154887), Rhinestone Basic Jewels (#144220), Blending Brushes (#153611), Black & White Gingham Ribbon (#156485)
- Other: Stampin' Seal (#152813), Mini Stampin' Dimensionals (#144108), Tear & Tape Adhesive (#138995), Multipurpose Liquid Glue (#110755), Mini Glue Dots (#103683)

Measurements:

- Card Base: Basic Black - 5 ½" x 8 ½", scored at 2 1/8"
- Cardstock #2: Fresh Freesia – 1 ½" x 5 ¼" (cut 4), 1 ¼" x 3"
- Cardstock #3: Basic White – 4" x 5 ¼", scrap for ghost and hat
- Designer Series Paper: Beautifully Penned – 1 ½" x 5" (cut 2)

Instructions:

- Fold the card base along the 2 1/8" score line. Gently fold the other side in to meet the edge in the middle and press fold using bone folder. (I do not score both sides because they don't always meet up perfectly when using score lines on both sides.)
- Attach the two Designer Series Paper pieces to the two of the Fresh Freesia 1 ½" x 5 ¼" pieces with the edges meeting on one side. This will leave a 1/8" matting around

just THREE sides. Attach both to front panels with matting toward the middle and place so they have the same matting in the center.

- On the other two Fresh Freesia strips, using Memento ink, stamp the brooms/hats from the Festive & Bright stamp set. Cut out both sides using the coordinating dies from the Festive Finishes Dies. Note: the dies will have a 1A and 1B on them to help you choose the correct dies.
- Color the hats and brooms using Blends markers. Trim along the bottom of the bottom hats. Attach to front of card along outside edges making sure the Designer Series Paper does not show. (I used liquid glue to apply so you have time to move it around a bit.)
- Using Memento Black ink, stamp Spooky on small Fresh Freesia piece and die cut using the frame die. Using Blending Brush and Gorgeous Grape ink, darken the frame with lighter and darker areas. Apply adhesive on the left side of the frame and attach to the left flap of the card.
- Die cut a ghost out of the Basic White scrap. Attach to frame using Mini Dimensionals.
- Attach large rhinestone to right side of frame.



- Inside of Card: Using Gorgeous Grape ink, stamp Happy Haunting from the Banner Year stamp set on the 4" x 5 1/4" Basic White piece.
- Take a piece of copy or grid paper and mask 1" up from the bottom of the Basic White piece. Using Memento Black ink, stamp the spider several times at differing heights and spacing. (The copy/grid paper will give the same top point of their webs.)
- Cut a 5" piece of the Black & White Gingham Ribbon. Color white portions using Dark Highland Heather Blends marker. Attach to Basic White piece at top point of the spider webs.
- Using Memento Black ink, stamp the middle hat on a scrap piece of Basic White. Color using the Blends markers. Fussy cut out and attach using Glue Dots.
