

Frightfully Cute

Supplies:

- Stamps: Frightfully Cute (#156487)
- Ink: Memento Black (3132708), Highland Heather (#147103), VersaMark (#102283)
- Paper: Smoky Slate (#131202), Gorgeous Grape (#146987); Basic White (#159276)
- Designer Paper: Beautifully Penned (#156630), Black Glitter (#153518), Pearlescent Specialty (#154291)
- Tools & Accessories: Stitched Rectangles (#151820), Frightful Tags (#156492), Brick & Mortar 3D Embossing Folder (#149643), Tombo Multipurpose Glue (#110755), Dimensionals – Mini (#144108), Blending Brushes (#153611)
- Other: White Embossing Powder (#155554), Heat Tool (129053)

Measurements:

- Card Base: Smoky Slate 8-1/2" x 5-1/2" scored at 4-1/4"
- Cardstock #2: Gorgeous Grape 5-3/8" x 4-1/8"
- Cardstock #3: Basic White 5" x 3-3/4" (for the back to write message & sign)
- Cardstock #4: Some scrap Black Glitter, Gorgeous Grape & Pearlescent for the fence, spider web, trees, bat & moon
- Designer Series Paper: 5" x 3-3/4"

Instructions:

- Cut, score & fold Smoky Slate card base. Using the 3rd from largest rectangle, center the die on the front of the card base – just a skosh above center (to leave a little extra room for the greeting piece – and cut out with the Die Cut Machine.
- Run the card front through the Die Cut Machine with the Brick & Mortar 3D Embossing Folder. Use one of your blending brushes and lightly brush the 'brick' card front with Smoky Slate ink.
- Glue/tape the piece of DSP to the layer of Gorgeous Grape and tape/glue it to the inside of the card base.
- Die cut 3 trees from Gorgeous Grape scrap; 4 fences from Black Glitter DSP; one spider web from Black Glitter DSP; and one moon from the Pearlescent paper.
- Stamp the bat with Memento Black in on a scrap of Gorgeous Grape and fussy cut leaving a very small edge of the Grape cardstock.
- I brushed the Pearlescent moon with a bit of the Highland Heather ink (let dry before handling).
- Using small dots of Tombo glue on the various 'pieces', create your vignette.
- Stamp the Halloween greeting with VersaMark on scrap Gorgeous Grape ink and heat emboss with White Embossing powder. Affix to the bottom center of the front of the card base with mini dimensionals.

Don't forget to decorate your envelope!
