Supplies:

- Stamps: Gorgeous Leaves #153365, Thinking Thanks & Peace #156552
- Ink: Cajun Craze #147085 Ink Refills: Cajun Craze #119790, Cherry Cobbler #119788, Pumpkin Pie #105229, Crushed Curry #131158, Granny Apple Green #147163, Crumb Cake #121029
- Paper: Basic White #159276, Cajun Craze #119684, Crushed Curry #131199,
- Tools & Accessories: Linen Thread #104199
- Other: Baby wipes
- Dies: Intricate Leaves Dies #153566

Measurements:

- Card Base: Cajun Craze, 8 1/2 x 5 1/2, plus piece to die cut leaf out of
- Cardstock #2: Crushed Curry 4 x 5 1/4
- Cardstock #3: Basic White, pieces to stamp leaves on,

Instructions:

- Fold baby wipe in four, drip several drops of the different colored ink refills in random blocks to create an ink pad to stamp your leaf images from. Press your stamped image onto the "Inked Up" baby wipe then stamp on basic white and repeat to stamp desired number of leaves

- Die cut out the stamped leaves, die cut out a detailed leaf in Cajun Craze
- Stamp sentiment on bottom of Crushed Curry cardstock in Cajun Craze ink
- Arrange and adhere die cut leaves in desired pattern
- Use glue dot to adhere linen thread bow
