Supplies:

- Stamps: Pretty Pumpkins #156472
- Ink: Calypso Coral, Versamark
- Paper: Crushed Curry, Basic White
- Designer Paper: Cork Specialty Paper #156393, Kraft Paper #156325, Harvest Meadow DSP
- Tools & Accessories: Detailed Pumpkin Dies #156477, Timeworn Type Embossing Folder #156505, Everyday Label Punch #144668
- Other: Soft Pastels Assortment #154585, Holiday Rhinestone Basic Jewels #150457

Measurements:

- Card Base: 8.5 x 5.5 inches
- Cardstock #2: 4 x 5.25 inches
- Cardstock #3: 1 x 5.5 inches (cork)
- Designer Series Paper: 3 x 4 inches

Instructions:

- Emboss the smaller piece of Crushed Curry cardstock with the Timeworn Type Embossing folder and attach to the cardbase.
- Attach the strip of cork to the card front with adhesive and then attach the piece of DSP with dimensionals.
- Stamp the detailed pumpkin with Versamark and then softly apply three of the colors of pastels to the pumpkin with your finger-- Daffodil Delight, Mango Melody, and Poppy Parade. Die cut with the pumpkin die.
- Stamp the sentiment in Calypso Coral ink and punch out. Attach both the label and the pumpkin with dimensionals.
- Decorate with rhinestones.
