

Peaceful Deer Card

Supplies:

- Stamps: Peaceful Deer #156891
- Ink: Evening Evergreen #155576, Soft Succulent #155778
- Paper: Cherry Cobbler #119685, Evening Evergreen #155574, Soft Succulent #155776, Basic White #159276
- Designer Paper: Tidings of Christmas #155718
- Tools & Accessories: Paper Trimmer #152392, Stampin' Seal #152813, Stampin' Dimensionals #104430, Evening Evergreen 3/8" Chevron Weave Ribbon #155722, Rhinestone Basic Jewels #144220, Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine #149653, Evergreen Forest 3D Embossing Folder #153576, Layering Circles #151770, Cherry Cobbler Stampin' Blends #154880

Measurements:

- Card Base: Cherry Cobbler 5 1/2" x 8 1/2"
- Cardstock #2: Evening Evergreen 5 1/4" x 4" and scrap
- Cardstock #3: Soft Succulent 5" x 2 1/4" and scrap
- Cardstock #4: Basic White 5 1/4" x 4" and scrap
- Designer Series Paper: White background with Evening Evergreen and Soft Succulent Stripes (running up and down) 5" x 1 3/4" tall, 5 1/4" wide x 1/2" tall

Instructions:

- Fold the piece of Cherry Cobbler cardstock in half to form the cardbase.
- Using the Cut & Emboss Machine and Evergreen Forest 3D Embossing folder, emboss the Soft Succulent cardstock panel. Adhere the embossed panel to the top half of the Evening Evergreen panel. Adhere the striped DSP panel on the bottom half of the panel. Use a piece of the Evening Evergreen Chevron ribbon to cover the seam, securing the ribbon ends behind the panel. Glue the entire panel onto the Cherry Cobbler card front.
- On the Basic White panel, stamp “Sending love & peace this season” in Soft Succulent ink. Stamp the sleeping deer on the bottom left corner in Evening Evergreen ink. Adhere the narrow strip of DSP across the top of the panel, and then glue the panel inside the card base.
- Cut the following using the Layered Circles dies:
 - 1 Evening Evergreen – 3rd smallest scalloped circle
 - 1 Evening Evergreen, 1 Cherry Cobbler – 2nd smallest scalloped circle
 - 1 Basic White, 1 Cherry Cobbler, 1 Evening Evergreen - 2nd smallest circle
 - 1 Soft Succulent, 1 Basic White – smallest scalloped circle
- Stamp the sleeping deer in Evening Evergreen ink on the White Scalloped Circle. Layer the stamped image on the Cherry Cobbler Circle and then the Evening Evergreen Scalloped Circle.
- Stamp the rabbit in Evening Evergreen on the Soft Succulent Scalloped Circle. Layer stamped image on the Evening Evergreen circle.
- Stamp the deer looking to the right on the White Circle. Layer the stamped image on the Cherry Cobbler scalloped circle and then the largest Evening Evergreen scalloped circle.
- Using dimensionals, adhere the three circles in the desired arrangement.
- Using the Dark Cherry Cobbler Stampin’ Blend, color three Rhinestones with the brush end. Adhere them to the cardfront as desired.
