Supplies:

- Stamps: Special Moments (#158081)
- Ink: Gorgeous Grape (#147099)
- Paper: Gorgeous Grape (#146987), Highland Heather (#146986), Basic White (#159276)
- Designer Paper: Simply Marbelous (#158128)
- Tools & Accessories: Stitched So Sweetly (#151690), Painted Texture Embossing Folder (#154317)

Measurements:

- Card Base: Gorgeous Grape – 8-1/2" x 5-1/2" scored at 5-1/4"
- Cardstock #2: Highland Heather – 5-1/4" x 4"
- Cardstock #3: Basic White – 5-1/4" x 4" for inside
- Cardstock #4: Gorgeous Grape – 3-3/4" x 1-1/2" (x 3)
- Designer Series Paper (DSP): Simply Marbelous – 3-5/8" x 1-3/8" (x 3)
- Scrap Gorgeous Grape & Simply Marbelous (for greeting tag)

Instructions:

- Fold the card base. Run the piece of Highland Heather through the Painted Texture Embossing folder. Tape/glue this to the front of the card base.
- Cut three pieces of the Simply Marbelous Designer Series Paper (the strongest swirly side). I cut them so the pattern would follow through across the pieces. Glue these to the three pieces of Gorgeous Grape.

- Space these three pieces across the front of the Highland Heather layer and glue them in place.
- Use a piece of scrap Gorgeous Grape and cut the largest (non-rectangular) die as the background layer for the greeting tag.
- Using the back side of your piece of Simply Marbelous DSP, stamp a greeting and die cut with second largest shape. Tape/glue this to the Gorgeous Grape tag shape. Use dimensionals and center this on the card front.
- Stamp a greeting on the Basic White layer – or leave it blank for writing a personal message.
- Tape/glue the Basic White layer to the inside of the card base. (Optional) Cut a ½” strip of DSP and glue it down the side of the White layer.

Use any of the beautiful colors of the Simply Marbelous DSP and coordinate it with a cardstock color for other versions of this card.
