Supplies:

- Stamps: On The Horizon #157770
- Ink: Evening Evergreen #155576
- Paper: Soft Succulent #155776, Evening Evergreen #155574, Basic White #159276
- Designer Paper: New Horizons #157768
- Tools & Accessories: Paper Trimmer #152392, Stampin' Seal + #149699, Stampin' Dimensionals #104430, Paper Snips #103579, Polished Dots #158134

Measurements:

- Card Base: Soft Succulent 8 ½ x 5 ½, scored at 4 ¼
- Cardstock #2: Basic White 5 ¼ x 4
- Cardstock #3: Evening Evergreen 2 x 5 ¼, 2 ⅝ square and 4 ¼ x ⅝
- Designer Series Paper: Pale Papaya 1 ⅞ x 5 ⅞, Flower Scene 2 ½ square and Blackberry Bliss 4 ¼ x ½

Instructions:

- Fold card base at score line.
- Attach 3 DSP pieces to coordinating Evening Evergreen layers & place (not attach) the layers on the card front where you think you want them to be and then stamp the sentiment in bottom right corner of card front in Evening Evergreen ink.
- Using Stampin' Seal attach the Pale Papaya layer to left side of the card front and the Blackberry Bliss strip near the center of the card keeping the left side aligned with the left edge of the Pale Papaya. Trim the right edge of the Blackberry strip even with the right edge of the card front. Attach the floral layer with dimensionals.
- Attach some polished dots under the sentiment.
- Stamp birds in Evening Evergreen on the Basic White layer and adhere inside card.
